



Reason For Supplemental Report:

I, Nick Fettig, Deputy State Fire Marshal was contacted from State Fire Marshal about a fire that occurred at 215 Cooper St, Rutland on December 13th, 2024. This report was to document the fire occurrence. No response from the North Dakota State Fire Marshal's Office was requested.

Remarks:

Fire Chief Maly reported a residential structure fire on Friday, December 13th. Fire Chief Maly indicated that all occupants evacuated the building safely and there were no injuries reported. The structure was a single-wide mobile home. One dog and two cats perished in the fire. The Fire Chief reported that there was possibly a Christmas tree that started or added to the fire. Fire Chief Maly stated that there were no incendiary fire indicators that he had noticed or was aware of. He stated that they worked with their local Sheriff's Department and determined that there was no foul play or intentional reason for the fire. Fire Chief Maly stated that he was not requesting assistance, just wanted to pass the information along.
